

# HOW TO INCREASE YOUR CHANCES OF A SURVIVING HEART ATTACK BY 1000%

For people who suffer from cardiac arrest outside of a medical facility, the survival rate is about 5%.

For those people who suffer cardiac arrest near an automatic heart stabilizing device called an automatic electronic defibrillator, or AED, the survival is far greater!

Defibrillators are small heart starting stabilizing devices that employ easy-to-understand, step by step instructions including voice directions They are designed so that even a 5<sup>th</sup> or 6<sup>th</sup> grader can operate it. When used on a heart attack/cardiac arrest victim immediately after the attack, the survival rate is greatly increased.

A defibrillator costs anywhere between \$1000 and \$3500 new.
